

### **SNAPSHOT**

**Member clubs 1987-1988 = 567 Member clubs now = 516** 

RED clubs - struggling & REQUIRE URGENT SUPPORT 28.5%

AMBER clubs - maintaining membership / participation 35%

**GREEN** clubs - operating well & growing membership 36.5%

Average age of club membership = 70?

# **Region Constitution**

Most changes are a 'flow-on' from the BV Constitution and/or BV Regulations

Some changes reflect what is delegated to Regions from BV

Clubs located within a Region recognised as members with voting rights

Divisions located within a Region recognised as members without voting rights

No change to BV retaining the sole power to discipline Individual Members, Clubs, Divisions & Regions

# **Region Constitution**

**Current Constitution** 

Directors elected each year
Risk of losing all director
knowledge, at one go

Possible change

Staggered director terms

Say half of the Board up for re-election each year Collective director knowledge is retained as new

director expertise & perspectives gained

# Board & Member Powers

#### CONSTITUTION

Constitutes the terms of a contract between the association and its members

#### **BOARD**

Conduct the business of the association on behalf of members

The affairs of the Club shall be managed by the Board

The Board shall control and manage the business and affairs of the Club.....

# **Director Removal**

Incorporations Act	A Committee Member may be removed from office by special resolution, in accordance with the rules of the Association
Model Rules	At a general meeting of the Association, a Committee Member by special resolution may be removed from office.
Pro Forma Constitution	The Region(Clubs) in a General Meeting may by Special Resolution remove any Director

# Conflict of Interest

Actual Conflict	Perceived Conflict	Potential Conflict		
where a director is likely to gain a personal advantage for themselves or a relative or a friend, because of their position as a director.	where others may reasonably perceive a conflict, and that perception may create a risk for the organisation with regard to reputation or financial assets.	where a process has been set in train that, in the future, may create a conflict of interest.		
Examples:  - A director's brother's company is being considered by the Club to undertake works  - The Club President is also a local Councillor. The Club & Council are in a dispute about the redevelopment of the Club.				
Director to Disclose/Declare	Not Present & Not Vote	Minutes and Conflict Register record Interest
