- Pennant Dates Season 2024/25. The proposed dates for next season Pennant Programme was confirmed. (Copy attached)
- Pennant Division Restructure Weekend Division A. The committee discussed the following:
 - AGM Feedback. 14 Clubs for retaining 16 players vs 12 Clubs for 12 players a Side in Weekend Division A.
 - Pennant Committee Decision.
 After lengthy discussion the committee decided on the following:
 - Divisions A1 A4 be retained as 16 player Sides
 - A new Division A5 be created to cater for the influx of new Sides. The committee decided that the new Division be 12 player Sides. This decision was made to enable clubs currently in B Division a gateway to enter Division A but are being held back due to the current promotion criteria. Obviously, this may be a one of opportunity where a greater number of B Division Sides can opt to move to Division A and be subject to the promotion and relegation conditions thereafter. However, under the current Sides structure (Div A1-A4) to be promoted in to Division A4 they will need to accept and then find 16 players.
 - B Division be retained as geographic and Sides of 12 players

ANNEXURE B

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PENNANT COMMITTEE

- 1. This committee shall consist of a maximum of seven (7) members who will be responsible for the conduct of Pennant in the region. The committee's responsibilities are:
 - 1.1. to coordinate the club's pennant sides applications and requests;
 - 1.2. to conduct the draw for the competition immediately entries have closed;
 - 1.3. to prepare a fixture program and circulate Pennant draw for the coming season;
 - 1.4. to advise clubs in writing of the various procedures applicable to the competition for that season, (Toolkit for side managers);
 - 1.5. to arrange the efficient conduct of the Pennant competition;
 - 1.6. to ensure the sides and results are accurately entered to the website BowlsLink after each round and confirm ladders for each Division using the appropriate program;
 - 1.7. to clarify any questions of player eligibility upon request by clubs;
 - 1.8. in conjunction with the Greens Committee, allocate greens for the final series; and
 - 1.9. in conjunction with the Umpires committee, consider and make recommendations for necessary changes to the Rules of Competition Bowls Victoria CoP for Pennant and send to the Board for ratification for consideration and action.
- 2. Within seven (7) days of any meeting of the Committee, the committee shall send a copy of the minutes and any supporting documentation to the Region Secretary.
